

Privacy Statement PreActive

This is the privacy statement of the company PreActive, hereinafter referred to as: PreActive. PreActive is registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number 80500188 and has its registered office at Bellamystraat 1 A 1 (1053BE) in Amsterdam. This document explains how PreActive deals with the processing of your personal data. In processing your personal data, PreActive will exercise the utmost care.

Acquisition of personal data

If you use the services of PreActive, you yourself provide PreActive with a number of personal details, or personal details are obtained from you as part of the agreement. Personal data is understood to mean all data relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.

Categories of personal data

PreActive processes the following categories of personal data:

- Contact details, including e-mail address and telephone number (if necessary);
- Name and address information, including name and location information if necessary;
- Business data, including VAT number and Chamber of Commerce number;
- Health data, including information pertaining to physical discomfort(s) (location; intensity; frequency), if explicitly agreed;
- Work related data concerning the employee if explicitly agreed upon;
- Financial data;
- Account details, including your password and username;
- Other personal details provided by you.

Purpose of processing

The personal details processed by PreActive have the following purpose:

- Contact you to inform you about the services purchased by you and the execution thereof;
- Perform its services;
- Improve its services;
- To be able to make payments;
- comply with legal obligations;
- to be able to make marketing and communication statements, including improving the website and/or application by analysing visitor behaviour on the website and/or application;
- be able to send newsletters;

- to exchange data with third parties for the purpose of executing the services, insofar as this is necessary.

Basis of processing

Personal data may only be processed on the basis of the following grounds: (i) legal obligation, (ii) performance of an agreement, (iii) explicit permission obtained from the parties concerned, and (iv) legitimate interest. Personal details are processed when providing the services of PreActive. PreActive only processes data that it considers necessary for (the improvement of) the services and it will handle the (personal) data collected about you and your use of the services with care. The basis for processing these details is the agreement you have entered into with PreActive. Personal data may also be processed by visiting the application and/or website if you have given your permission.

Necessity of processing

The processing of your personal data is necessary in order to perform the services. The services offered by PreActive cannot be fully performed without the processing of your personal data. If for specific purposes relating to the personal data your explicit permission is required, you must give your separate permission for this.

Automated decision-making

There is no question of automated decision-making.

Storage period

The personal data processed by PreActive will be stored in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations. If a longer retention period is necessary on the basis of legislation or regulations, the personal data will be kept longer in accordance with these requirements. All personal data (obtained) will not be stored longer than strictly necessary.

Processing by third parties

PreActive only shares personal data with third parties if this is strictly necessary for the execution of an agreement and to comply with relevant laws and regulations. No personal details are sold. PreActive may be under a legal obligation to share personal data with third parties. If personal data is shared with third parties, processing agreements are concluded. The third parties with whom personal data is shared are:

- The Bookkeeper, for the purpose of executing an agreement. The categories of personal data that are processed are contact and name and address details and financial data.

- Software suppliers, for the purpose of executing the agreement. The categories of personal data that are processed are contact and name and address details.
- Website manager and/or application manager, for the purpose of executing the agreement. The categories of personal data that are processed are the contact and name and address details.
- Engaged third parties, for the purpose of executing the agreement. The categories of personal data that are processed are the contact and name and address details.

Cookie Statement

PreActive uses technical and functional cookies to optimise the website and/or application. Cookies are small text files that are sent when visiting a website and/or application in order to make the visitor's experience more efficient. PreActive is allowed by law to store cookies on your device if these cookies are strictly necessary to use the website and/or application. For other types of cookies, your consent is required. PreActive recommends that you accept the cookies in connection with the user-friendliness of the website and/or application. Visitors to the website and/or application have a check-in option.

The cookies PreActive uses are functional cookies: these cookies ensure that the website and/or application works properly. These cookies have no effect on privacy, so no permission must be requested and granted. This profile is not linked to your name, address, e-mail address and the like, and is only used to tailor advertisements to your profile so that they are as relevant to you as possible.

The PreActive website is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to show our services to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall.

Use of social media

PreActive uses cookies from third parties to optimise the website. Some cookies are placed by third-party services displayed on the website. Third parties are Wix.com and social media (LinkedIn). The use of cookies from other companies (third parties) is subject to the privacy and cookie policy of the company concerned. When you click the social media button on the website, a social media cookie is placed. This allows the social media party to recognise your IP address when you share an article on the website. E-mail newsletter and other marketing mails

You can register for a newsletter and/or other commercial offers through the website. Browser settings

If you do not want websites to place cookies on the device you use to view the website, you can adjust your browser settings. Right of data subjects

As a data subject, you have the following rights:

- Right of access;
As a data subject, you have the right to be informed whether or not your personal data are being processed and, if so, to have access to them.
- Right to rectification;
You have the right to obtain rectification and completion of incorrect data.
- Right to erasure;
Without unreasonable delay, a data subject shall obtain the erasure of personal data concerning them.
- Right to restriction of processing;

- Right to data portability;
